

CULINARY TRAIL

Wherever you go in the greater Portland area, you're never far from a vineyard or farm — which is a big part of why the city is at the forefront of the “FLOSS” (fresh, local, organic, seasonal and sustainable) food movement.

SAMPLE ONE-DAY ITINERARY

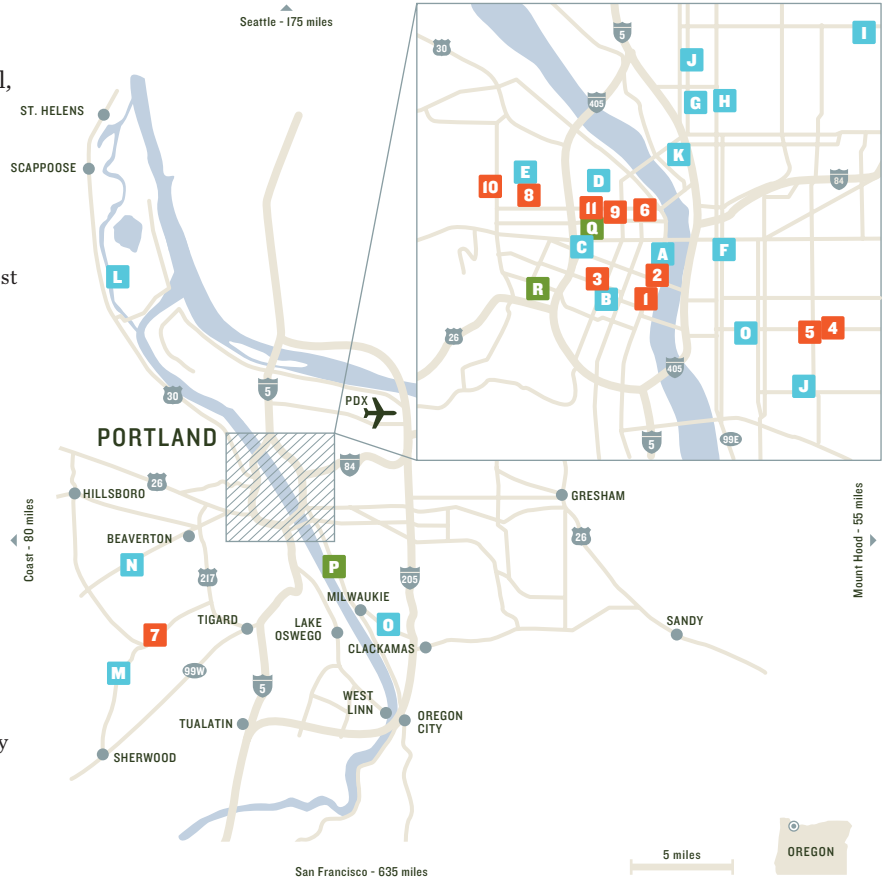
Start the day with breakfast at local favorite **1 BIJOU CAFÉ** (132 S.W. Third Ave.), a comfortable spot known for Northwest specialties like Willapa Bay oyster scramble. Grab a cup of joe (arguably the city's best — but there are many contenders) at **2 STUMPTOWN COFFEE ROASTERS** (stumptowncoffee.com).

Next, visit the **3 PORTLAND FARMERS MARKET** (portlandfarmersmarket.org), where you'll find the freshest of fresh fruits, vegetables, flowers and baked goods, plus artisan cheeses and other delicacies. There are four market locations, open various days from May-October.

Cross the river and head to the Hawthorne District to browse cookbooks at **4 POWELL'S BOOKS FOR HOME AND GARDEN** (powells.com) before grabbing a bite at gourmet European-style market **5 PASTAWORKS** (pastaworks.com) or one of the neighborhood's cafés or brewpubs.

Thirsty? You're in luck — just outside Portland, the Willamette Valley is home to more than 100 wineries. After lunch, sample a local Pinot Noir — in town, at **6 METROVINO** (metrovinopdx.com), or a half-hour drive southwest of Portland at **7 PONZI VINEYARDS** (ponzivines.com).

Back in town, enjoy dinner at one of the great establishments in northwest Portland. The challenge will be in the choosing. **8 PALEY'S PLACE** (paleysplace.net), on Northwest 23rd, is a pioneer of the local food movement, while the Pearl District's **9 PARK KITCHEN** (parkkitchen.com) earned a 2007 James Beard Best Chef Northwest nomination.



After dinner, Nob Hill's **10 PAPA HAYDN** (papahaydn.com) is a sure bet for dessert. For a nightcap, the **11 TEARDROP COCKTAIL LOUNGE** (teardroplounge.com) in the Pearl serves classic cocktails featuring handmade mixers.
